



Stephen Webster MD is on the staff of the Gundersen Lutheran Medical Center in La Crosse Wisconsin. He joined Gundersen Lutheran in 1971 in the Department of Dermatology, was named teacher of the Year in 1978, and was Vice-President from 1984-1988. He is a Clinical Professor of Dermatology at the University of Minnesota Medical School, and Associate Clinical Professor of Dermatology at the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health. At the Academy of Dermatology he was Secretary-Treasurer 1985-1988 and President in 1991. He received the Gold Medal
